





# GENUINE DOOR MIRROR GARNISH

## INSTALLATION AND USER'S INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for purchasing a genuine Mazda accessory.  
Before removal and installation, be sure to thoroughly read these instructions.  
Please read the contents of this booklet in order to properly install and use the door mirror garnish. Your safety depends on it.  
Keep these instructions with your vehicle records for future reference.

### **WARNING**

- There are several  **WARNING** and  **CAUTION** sections in this booklet concerning safety when installing or removing the door mirror garnish. Always read and follow them in order to prevent injuries, accidents, and possible damage to the vehicle.
  -  **WARNING:** Indicates a situation in which serious injury or death could result if the warning is ignored.
  -  **CAUTION:** Indicates a situation in which bodily injury or damage to the vehicle could result if the caution is ignored.
- For areas indicating the tightening torque in this instruction manual, tighten to the specified torque using a torque wrench. For areas in which the tightening torque is indicated inside parentheses ( ), the tightening torque is indicated as a reference value, however tightening using a torque wrench is not necessary
- Do not modify the door mirror garnish.
- Do not install the door mirror garnish in any way other than described in the following instructions.
- If in any doubt, please ask your Mazda dealer to install the accessory in order to prevent errors in installation.
- If you have any questions about the use of the accessory, ask your Mazda dealer for proper advice before using it.
- Mazda and its suppliers are not responsible for injuries, accidents, and damage to persons and property that arise from the failure of the dealer or installer to follow these instructions.
- To ensure safety and reliability of the work, installation, removal and disposal work must be carried out by an Authorized Mazda Dealership.
- Be careful not to lose removed parts, and be sure that they are kept free from scratches, grease or other dirt.

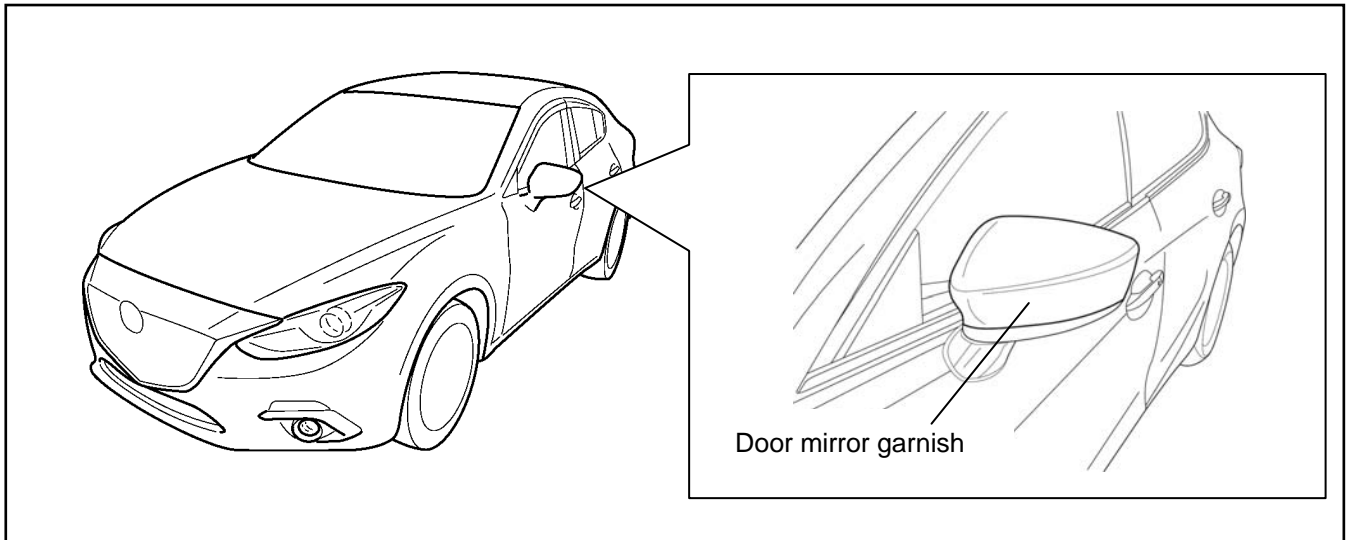

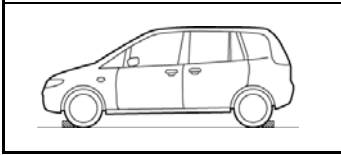
## 3. BEFORE INSTALLATION

### ■ REQUIRED TOOLS

- ☆Fastener remover    ☆Tape-wrapped flathead screwdriver
- ☆Tape    ☆Soft, clean cloth

### ⚠ WARNING

Park the vehicle on a flat, level surface, set the selector lever to P (AT vehicles) or the shift lever to 1st or R (MT vehicles), apply the parking brake and block the wheels so that the vehicle does not move during installation.



### ⚠ CAUTION

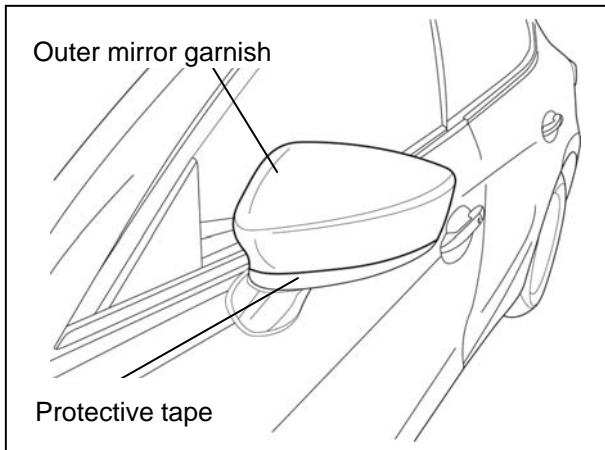
<p>Be sure to cover the vehicle body with protectors or mats to prevent stains, scratches and damage when removing/installing the vehicle parts</p>	<p>Using improper tools may cause damage and or broken parts. Use the correct tool for the job.</p>	<p>Put the removed parts and the parts in the kit on the protective sheet to prevent scratches.</p>

### Note

Refer to the Workshop Manual for removal and installation of vehicle parts. Not following the procedures for removal/installation in the Workshop Manual could result in an accident or vehicle malfunction.



## 4. VEHICLE PART REMOVAL



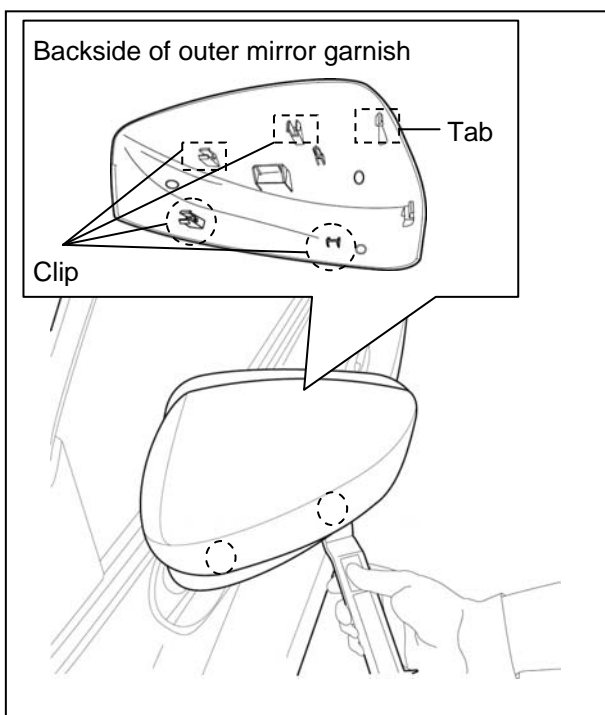
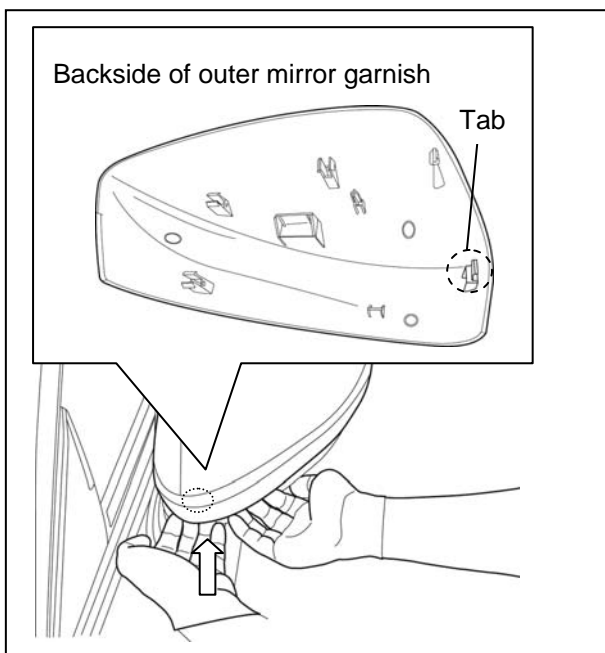
- The figure shows the left side, however, perform the same procedure for the right side.

### Outer mirror garnish removal

1. Affix protective tape (such as masking tape) around the installation surfaces of the outer mirror and the outer mirror garnish to prevent scratching the vehicle and the parts.
2. Insert your fingers into the area of the outer mirror garnish shown by the arrow in the figure and remove the tab (1 location: [○]).

#### ⚠ CAUTION

- Always wear gloves to prevent injury.



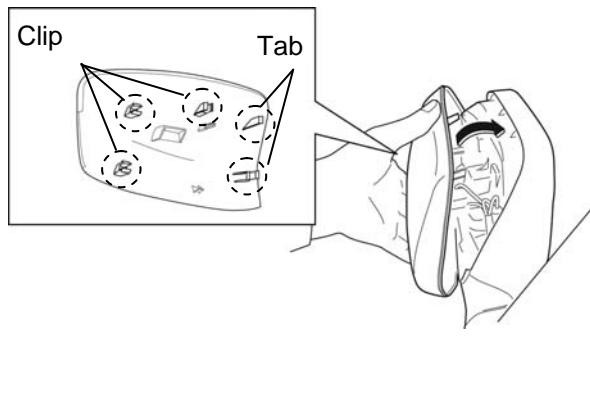
3. Remove the clips (2 locations: [○]) using the fastener remover.
4. Remove the remaining clips (2 locations: [□]) and tab (1 location: [□]).
5. Remove the outer mirror garnish from the outer mirror.

#### ⚠ CAUTION

- The removed outer mirror garnish is not used for this accessory.

## 5. DOOR MIRROR GARNISH INSTALLATION

Backside of door mirror garnish



1. Align the door mirror garnish clips and tabs with the outer mirror installation parts.
2. Support the outer mirror with your hand and install the door mirror garnish to the outer mirror installation surface so that there are no gaps while slowly applying force.

- Do not apply excessive force. Otherwise, damage or cracking may occur.

3. Peel off the protective tape affixed around the outer mirror and wipe the door mirror garnish with a soft cloth.

### ⚠ CAUTION

- Be careful not to damage the door mirror garnish.

## 6. NOTICE ON HANDLING

### ⚠ WARNING

- Do not place the door mirror garnish near an open flame (such as lighted cigarette) or volatile solvent (such as thinner, alcohol). They could cause a fire or deformation.
- This accessory is made of plastic. Do not hit or apply excessive force to it. Otherwise damage or cracks could occur.
- If the mirror trim cap becomes dirty, clean it in the same way as the surface of the body.
- Do not use thinner, benzene, gasoline or any organic solvent. They will cause damage to the surface of vehicle and installed parts.
