- For areas indicating the tightening torque in this instruction manual, tighten to the specified torque using a torque wrench. For areas in which the tightening torque is indicated inside parentheses (), the tightening torque is indicated as a reference value, however tightening using a torque wrench is not necessary.
- Do not modify the aluminum brake pedal kit.
- Do not install the aluminum brake pedal kit in any way other than described in the following instructions.

- If you have any questions about the use of the accessory, ask your Mazda dealer for proper advice before using it.



⚠ WARNING

Be sure to cover the vehicle body with protectors or mats to prevent stains, scratches and damage when removing/installing the vehicle parts	Wrap protective tape around screwdrivers and fastener remover tools to prevent scratching the vehicle.	Put the removed parts and the parts in the kit on the protective sheet to prevent scratches.






4. ALUMINUM BRAKE PEDAL INSTALLATION




Existing brake pedal pad removal

- 1. Remove the brake pedal pad.
 - The removed pads are not used for installation of this kit. Store the removed parts carefully in a safe place.



Aluminum brake pedal pad installation

- 1. Pour lukewarm water into a basin.
- 2. Add mild detergent to the lukewarm water to a 5 % solution.
- Soak the pedal pad in the solution until the rubber rim of the pedal pad is softened sufficiently. Pull the pedal pad out of the basin, and wipe off its surface and back side using a soft, clean cloth.
- 4. Stretch the rubber rim of brake pedal pad over the top part of the brake pedal.



- 5. Insert a flathead screwdriver wrapped with Protective tape (stubby type) into the bottom underside gap between the brake pedal and the rubber rim of the brake pedal pad.
- While stretching the rubber rim outward, install the brake pedal pad so that it covers the pedal completely in the order of (1), (2), (3), and (4) shown in the figure.
 - Make sure that the brake pedal pad is securely installed to the brake pedal.

-TO THE CUSTOMER-

- Please check that there are no slack or vibration of screw. Periodical inspection is required.
- Please be careful of the following points for taking care of this product.
 - 1. Please do not use hard tools, such as brush when you wash this. It may damage the surface.
 - 2. Please wash the product with water after using thinned neutral detergent, when it is hard to clean off by washing without soap.
