- For areas indicating the tightening torque in this instruction manual, tighten to the specified torque using a torque wrench. For areas in which the tightening torque is indicated inside parentheses (), the tightening torque is indicated as a reference value, however tightening using a torque wrench is not necessary
- Do not modify the aluminum footrest.
- Do not install the aluminum footrest in any way other than described in the following instructions.
- If in doubt, please contact your Mazda dealer to install the accessory in order to prevent errors in installation.
- If you have any questions about the use of the accessory, ask your Mazda dealer for proper advice before using it.
- Mazda and its suppliers are not responsible for injuries, accidents, and damage to persons and property that arise from the failure of the dealer or installer to follow these instructions.



3. VERIFICATION ITEMS BEFORE INSTALLATION

Required tools

☆Thread sealer

☆Phillips screwdriver

☆Torque wrench

☆Drill (2.5 mm, 6 mm)



/ WARNING

Before performing any work, park the vehicle on level ground, apply the parking brake securely, and then block the wheels. If the vehicle moves while performing work, it may cause injury.





CAUTION

Use masking tape or a protector to prevent scratches when removing/installing parts.	Use the most appropriate (size, use) tool for each task and perform the work correctly. (Otherwise) the parts may be damaged.	Place the removed parts and kit accessories on a protective sheet to prevent scratches.	Wrap protective tape around screwdrivers and fastener remover tools to prevent scratching the vehicle.

When drilling the body using a drill or hole saw, use a protective sheet or tape to prevent drill shavings from penetrating the vehicle. Otherwise, it may cause abnormal noise or rust.	When drilling the body using a drill or hole saw, always wrap with duct tape to prevent scratching and over-drilling.	After drilling holes, remove burrs completely.	






1. Remove the clip shown in the figure.

Scuff plate, weatherstrip, and side trim removal


- 1. Remove in the order indicated in the figure.


5. ALUMINUM FOOTREST INSTALLATION

- Temporarily place the aluminum footrest using the corner roundings of the footrest as a reference as shown in the figure.
- 2. Mark the two locations using screw holes.





- 3. Remove the aluminum footrest.
- 4. Wrap the drill bit with duct tape as shown in the figure.
- 5. Set the drill speed to low.


ADVICE

- Always use a drill with a rotation speed adjustment.
- Be careful when handling drill bits.
- When drilling the holes, be careful not to drill so deeply that it reaches sponge part underneath.
- 6. With the drill bit pointed perpendicular to the footrest, drill holes in the marked positions in stages.


Hole drilling: $\phi 2.5 \rightarrow \phi 6$







 Partially pull back the carpet and install the nut plate to the backside of the aluminum footrest installation area.
 At this time, point the V-notch of the nut plate downward.



- 9. Apply thread sealer to the screw (2) ends.
- 10. Install the aluminum footrest to the nut plate using screws (2).

Screw tightening torque: 1.0-1.4 Nm

11. Install the side wall in the reverse order of removal.

- Please be careful of the following points for taking care of this product.
 - 1. Please do not use hard tools, such as brush when you wash this. It may damage the surface.
 - 2. Please wash the product with water after using thinned neutral detergent, when it is hard to clean off by washing without soap.
